SUBJECT: PEDIATRIC INTUBATION MODULE I

ICEMA has developed an educational module to assist your agency with pediatric intubation training, beginning with *Pediatric Intubation Basics - Module I*. This is the first part of a series of modules focused solely on pediatric intubation. This is a **mandatory** educational module for paramedics and recommended for EMTs and nurses. Education must be completed no later than March 31, 2013.

ICEMA has approved this education module for two (2) hours of continuing education (CE) credits.
