SUBJECT: REDDINET DRILLS

In an effort to increase compliance and proficiency on the new MCI and messaging modules there will be scheduled drills starting in January 2013. There will be one month of scheduled drills, which will be held once per week, per shift. Beginning in February 2013, drills will be unscheduled, but will consist of the same parts. A full drill will take approximately 20 minutes and will include the following components:

1. Update Alert Status, when requested.
2. Respond to a Message with a reply, when requested.
3. Respond to an MCI, when requested. This will include arriving ambulances and entering patient names into the appropriate ReddiNet area.
4. Respond to a simple one or two question Assessment Poll. This will typically consist of one or two questions requiring a narrative answer from facilities.
