SUBJECT: REVISED REDDINET POLLS

On January 9, 2013, ICEMA sent out a memorandum regarding changes in the frequency of the polls ICEMA conducts via ReddiNet. As a result of discussions with the hospitals during the January meeting of the Healthcare Preparedness Planning Partners (HP3), the San Bernardino County Department of Public Health has requested that the epidemiologic poll be conducted once per day at 2359 hours, for the previous 24-hour period (2400 hours to 2359 hours).

Hospitals are required to respond to the poll no later than 0700 hours each day. A reminder will be automatically sent via the ReddiNet each morning to ensure compliance. Hospitals not updating the polls will be contacted individually by the MHOAC and/or designees.

The revised poll will commence today, January 16, 2013, at 2359 hours and is expected to be reported by 0700 hours tomorrow, January 17, 2013, for the previous 24-hour period.

Please note that this memorandum does not affect the HAvBED poll which remains twice per day at 0800 and 2000 hours.
