SUBJECT: NINTH BRAIN

ICEMA is replacing the current Education Content Manager from Ninth Brain with a new system that will enable ICEMA to more easily adapt to online certification/accreditation for Emergency Medical Service (EMS) providers. The new system, from ImageTrend, will allow ICEMA to integrate educational and testing components with a new online certification/accreditation process for use by EMTs, EMT-Ps, and MICNs. The new system will roll out over the next year.

The first phase of the project, starting in July, will include moving the current information from Ninth Brain into the new system. This will require that users stop using the current Ninth Brain Suite. Future phases include the adoption of a new ICEMA evaluation/testing system to replace Ninth Brain and online certification/accreditation for EMS specialties administered by ICEMA. You should continue to obtain your continuing education and training through your regular resources as this system is not being designed to replace provider sponsored or conducted education and training.

To transition to the new system, the current Ninth Brain Content Management System has been shut down effective June 3, 2013. Access for providers will be available until July 1, 2013, for those wishing to print certificates.
