SUBJECT: PEDIATRIC AIRWAY MANAGEMENT BASICS - MODULE II

ICEMA has developed a follow up to the pediatric educational module to assist with pediatric intubation training. The second module, *Pediatric Airway Management Basics - Module II* is the second part of the series of modules focused on pediatric intubation. Along with Module I, this is a **mandatory** educational module for paramedics and nurses and recommended for EMTs and AEMTs. This module must be completed no later than **December 31, 2013**.

ICEMA has approved this education module and test for two (2) hours of continuing education (CE) credits.

Under "Continuing Education & Training," select "Continuing Education" then click on the green bar labeled "ICEMA Training Modules". DVDs are available upon request. Providers will be responsible for issuing CE certificates.
