**SUBJECT:** EMS HOSPITAL PRINTERS

The rollout of the new electronic Patient Care Report system has progressed ahead of schedule. Most EMS providers who were using the old electronic system have transitioned to the new ICEMA EMS Data System. With this comes the ability for hospitals to view incoming patients and print reports directly from the Hospital Dashboard.

Effective September 1, 2013, ICEMA will officially transition from the current EMS printed document to ones generated from the Hospital Dashboard. The Hospital Dashboard will allow hospitals to print patient documents directly from the dashboard to any hospital-networked printer. This will allow records to be viewed and printed as required, by authorized users, from various locations independent of the ICEMA supplied printer. In addition, effective September 1, 2013, ICEMA will discontinue providing the consumables for the printers that were installed at your facility. ICEMA will continue to support the wireless connections and hardware as a redundant resource for printing.
