**SUBJECT:** HOSPITAL BED DELAY INFORMATION FOR JUNE 2013

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The Inland Counties EMS Agency (ICEMA) is providing hospital bed delay information utilizing data retrieved through the electronic patient care records (ePCR) submitted by participating providers. Enclosed is the June 2013 report.

ICEMA and the ambulance providers have been working in conjunction with various hospitals to help assure the accuracy of this report. Please be advised that the data collected reflects precisely the times documented on the prehospital patient care records. As we have discussed with both prehospital and hospital representatives, it is imperative that the electronic patient care record be signed by a nurse as soon as the patient is taken off the ambulance gurney. This will help assure that automatic times recorded on the prehospital patient care record are consistent with those recorded on hospital records.

The following information is provided for all San Bernardino County 9-1-1 receiving hospitals:

The total number of:

- 9-1-1 transports to each facility.
- Transports that resulted in bed delay.
- Hours as a result of bed delay (Bed delay hours/minutes is calculated beginning 25 minutes after unit arrives at facility).

Please share this report with your staff and help ensure hospital staff understands the importance of decreasing bed delays in order that EMS units are able to respond to 9-1-1 calls.



## Report Detail


This report collects and summarizes the "Bed Delay" or "Off-Load Time" for a selected group of hospitals. "Bed Delay" is the time between arrival of an ambulance at a hospital and the hospital receiving the patient. The first 25 minutes of "Bed Delay" are excluded from consideration. The only type of runs that are considered are 911 or Mutual Aid calls where the patient is treated and transported via ambulance.


