**SUBJECT: EMS EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR PARAMEDIC AND MOBILE  
INTENSIVE CARE NURSE CREDENTIALING**

Effective immediately, ICEMA will no longer require specific continuing education (CE), skills or field care audits as part of the ICEMA credentialing process for paramedics (EMT-Ps) and Mobile Intensive Care Nurses (MICNs). Additionally, MICN ride outs are no longer required. A Medical Advisory Committee (MAC) task force achieved consensus and proposed these changes. The ICEMA Medical Director has accepted and approved the MAC task force recommendations.

EMT-Ps and MICNs must still provide copies of their State license, BLS and ACLS cards to ICEMA as part of the credentialing process required to maintain local EMT-P accreditation or MICN authorization. Proof of having completed the 2013 Pediatric Airway Modules 1 and 2 is required for one (1) credentialing cycle. Future education or training that may be required by ICEMA or State licensure is not part of the ongoing credentialing process.

EMT-Ps and MICNs are required to maintain their State issued licenses, including satisfy all continuing educational requirements.
