SUBJECT: EMT-P ACCREDITATION CLARIFICATION

Effective September 1, 2015, ICEMA Reference #1040 - EMT-P Accreditation was revised to simplify the accreditation process resulting in the elimination of provisional accreditations.

The California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 9, Chapter 4, Section 100166 states EMT-Ps may practice in the basic scope of practice as a second EMT-P until he or she is accredited. The EMT-P accreditation applicant may only practice the local optional scope of practice while in the presence of the field evaluator who is ultimately responsible for patient care.

EMT-Ps will be accredited once the EMT-P has applied for ICEMA accreditation, successfully passed the local optional skills exam, and employment is confirmed. The EMS provider will be notified via e-mail once the EMT-P has completed the accreditation process.
