SUBJECT: NEMESIS V3 DATA SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Recent legislation and the addition of 1797.227 to the California Health and Safety Code requires the collection and submission of data by all EMS transport and non-transport providers to the local EMS agency by January 1, 2017. According to the new regulation, this data must be electronic and compliant with the current version of the National Emergency Medical System Information System (NEMESIS).

ICEMA is aware that some EMS providers in Inyo and Mono Counties may be unable to meet these requirements within the timeframes allowed in the regulations. ICEMA is willing to work with EMS providers in finding solutions that will satisfy the law without placing any undue hardship on volunteer personnel. ICEMA will consider any request for a delay or waiver in the implementation of these requirements for EMS providers meeting the following criteria.

- Be a volunteer non-transport EMS provider, and
- Primary service is in Inyo or Mono Counties, and
- Request a waiver or delay in implementation prior to December 1, 2016, and
- Demonstrate a need for waiver.
