## ePCR IMPLEMENTATION NEMSIS V3

ICEMA announced the dates of the NEMSIS V3 roll out to begin on February 6, 2017, with a completion date of February 28, 2017. On March 1, 2017, ICEMA providers entered and completed 1,107 reports. With the exception of the few providers noted below, all ICEMA providers are live. One provider is not reporting and has not attended any meetings. ICEMA continues to hold meetings with providers to review the roll out and work on issues as they may come up.

## IMAGETREND SOFTWARE

The purchase of ImageTrend Software was approved by the ICEMA Governing Board in November 2011.

Patient Registry - ICEMA continues to receive data from its Trauma, Stroke and STEMI registries.

Trial Studies and Pilot Programs - ICEMA developed and deployed specific forms for documentation related to the TXA Trial Study.

Community Paramedicine Pilot Program went live August 17, 2015. ICEMA is currently receiving ePCRs. Community Paramedicine documentation will remain on Field Bridge V2 after January 1, 2017.

With the passage of AB 1129 LEMSAs can no longer mandate a provider to use the LEMSA's data system or its vendor. ICEMA is in the process of releasing a data policy outlining the requirements of AB 1129 that mandates data reporting to the LEMSA. ICEMA will work with any provider to make the transition as smooth as possible, while ensuring patient continuity is maintained. It is ICEMA's desire to keep the process as close to the current process and not add any additional work to the downstream providers. \*\*

\*\* Ontario Fire Department has notified ICEMA they will be going on their own ePCR system.

## STATE DATA REPOSITORY

Total ePCRs as of May 15, 2017, is 735,483.
