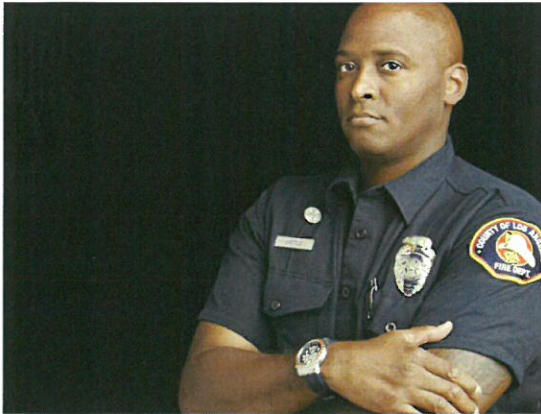


NATIONAL REGISTRY PARAMEDIC REFRESHER
