SUBJECT: QUALIFIED VENDOR LIST FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES

RECOMMENDATION(S)

Approve list of qualified vendors for Information Technology Services.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

County departments, including the Information Services Department (ISD), have a need to contract with qualified professionals to provide programming, database design, project management and other professional and technical services in order to meet information technology (IT) workload requirements.

On April 12, 2005, (Item No. 46) the Board approved the release of request for qualifications (RFQ) 05-01 for IT services. The purpose of this RFQ was to pre-qualify IT firms that County departments could contract with to augment their IT service needs. Subsequently, on May 24, 2005, (Item No. 52) the Board approved a list of 45 qualified IT service vendors, effective for three years. This pre-qualified vendor list has expired. On February 10, 2009, (Item No. 42), the Board approved the release of request for qualifications 09-01 for IT services, to pre-qualify IT firms that County departments can contract with to augment IT service needs.

ISD evaluated 73 Qualification Applications (QA) in twelve service categories including application development, project management, business consulting, systems programming and network server support. After review of the applicant's responses to the terms set forth in the QA, and evaluation of their service capability, ISD is recommending the following agencies be included on a qualified vendor list for IT services available to County departments. Personnel from firms on the approved list will be available to augment the work efforts of current County IT staff as needed.

This list, which will remain in effect for a period of three years, streamlines the process for County departments needing to obtain professional IT services by eliminating the requirement for a formal request for proposals (RFP) each time contract services are needed. As IT projects arise, the applicable department shall request a quote from the vendors above and review at least three responses. Per County Policy No. 11-05, the department shall return to the Board of Supervisors for approval of any contract in excess of \$100,000 with the selected vendor.

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FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of this item will not result in additional general fund financing. Expenditures from departments using these services will be approved within each department's budget.
