

**NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING ON MARCH 22, 2010, FOR
LAFCO 3098 – REORGANIZATION TO INCLUDE ANNEXATIONS TO BEAUMONT-CHERRY
VALLEY WATER DISTRICT AND SAN GORGONIO PASS WATER AGENCY, AND DETACHMENT
FROM SAN BERNARDINO VALLEY MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT**

Notice is hereby given that a Protest Hearing will be held by the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) of San Bernardino County. The hearing will be held at the LAFCO Office at 215 N. "D" St., Suite 204, San Bernardino, California 92415-0490, on March 22, 2010, at 2:00 p.m., to hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which are made, presented, or filed regarding LAFCO 3098.

The reorganization for annexation to Beaumont-Cherry Valley Water District and San Gorgonio Pass Water Agency encompasses approximately 589+/- acres generally bordered by the Riverside County line on the south, a combination of parcel boundaries and Oak Glen Road (portion of existing BCVWD boundary) on the west, and parcel boundaries on the north and east. The reorganization area includes portions of Sections 1, 2, 10 and 11, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, San Bernardino Meridian. The area for annexation to San Gorgonio Pass Water Agency and detachment from San Bernardino Valley Municipal Water District encompasses approximately 6+/- acres that includes Assessor Parcel Number 0235-111-24, and the easterly right-of-way of Oak Glen Road fronting the parcel.

Proceedings for this reorganization were initiated by the Beaumont-Cherry Valley District and submitted to LAFCO. This proposal has been assigned the short-form designation of LAFCO 3098.

The proposed terms and conditions for this reorganization are set forth in LAFCO Resolution No. 3084 adopted by the Commission on January 20, 2010 which is available for review in the LAFCO office.

The reason for this proposal, as provided by the Beaumont-Cherry Valley Water District, is:

To maintain control of the groundwater quality of the District's existing wells, provide wellhead protection and manage the District's facilities more efficiently.

Any owner of land within the territory proposed to be reorganized may file an official protest. Such protest must be made in writing and submitted to the LAFCO office prior to the conclusion of the hearing. The written protest must include your name, address, address of the land owned within the affected area if different from your residence, Assessor Parcel Number and LAFCO number. The written protest must be dated. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax.
