

**NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING ON MAY 14, 2009, FOR  
LAFCO 3116 – ANNEXATION TO COUNTY SERVICE AREA 42 (ORO GRANDE)**

Notice is hereby given that a Protest Hearing will be held by the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) of San Bernardino County. The hearing will be held at the LAFCO Office at 215 N. "D" St., Suite 204, San Bernardino, California 92415-0490, on **May 14, 2009** at 2:00 p.m., to hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which are made, presented, or filed regarding LAFCO 3116.

The annexation area encompasses approximately 16.98+/- acres and is generally located east of the Mojave River and north of the City of Victorville, within the community of Oro Grande. The area is generally bordered by a combination of the National Trails Highway right-of-way and parcel boundaries (portion of existing CSA 42 boundaries) on the north, parcel boundaries (existing CSA 42 boundaries) on the east and south, and a combination of the National Trails Highway right-of-way and parcel boundaries on the west.

Proceedings for this annexation were initiated by San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors and submitted to LAFCO. This proposal has been assigned the short-form designation of LAFCO 3116.

The proposed terms and conditions for this annexation are set forth in LAFCO Resolution No. 3053 adopted by the Commission on March 18, 2009, which is available for review in the LAFCO office, located at 215 N. "D" Street, Suite 204, San Bernardino, CA 92415-0490.

The reason for this proposal, as provided by the County, is:

This annexation will allow for the provision of water service to six parcels. A water line extension and a new water well are a requirement to service the parcels and they both are a condition to annexation and must be in place prior to CSA 42 providing service to the parcels.

Any owner of land within the territory proposed to be reorganized may file an official protest. Such protest must be made in writing and submitted to the LAFCO office at the address listed above prior to the conclusion of the hearing. The written protest must include your name, address, address of the land owned within the affected area if different from your residence, Assessor Parcel Number and LAFCO number. The written protest must be dated. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax.
