

**NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING ON JUNE 11, 2009, FOR
LAFCO 3128 – REORGANIZATION TO INCLUDE CITY OF FONTANA ANNEXATION
NO. 172 AND DETACHMENT FROM COUNTY SERVICE AREAS 70 AND SL-1**

Notice is hereby given that a Protest Hearing will be held by the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) of San Bernardino County. The hearing will be held at the LAFCO Office at 215 N. "D" St., Suite 204, San Bernardino, California 92415-0490, on **June 11, 2009**, at 10:00 a.m., to hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which are made, presented, or filed regarding LAFCO 3128.

The reorganization area encompasses approximately 5+/- acres and is generally bordered by Calabash Avenue on the west, parcel lines (existing City boundary) on the north, and parcel lines on the east and south.

The reorganization area is more specifically described in the legal description and map which can be accessed below.

Proceedings for this reorganization were initiated by the City of Fontana and submitted to LAFCO. This proposal has been assigned the short-form designation of LAFCO 3128.

The proposed terms and conditions for this reorganization are set forth in LAFCO Resolution No. 3055 adopted by the Commission on April 15, 2009, which is available for review in the LAFCO office.

The reason for this proposal, as provided by the City of Fontana, is:

The area was inadvertently omitted from an annexation that occurred in 2005. This annexation includes the southern half of the Sierra Vista Mobile Home Estates at 8191 Calabash Avenue. The City wishes to provide municipal services, such as street sweeping, graffiti abatement and tree trimming. The new annexation area will adjust the City's corporate boundary and alleviate any confusion regarding the delivery of municipal services.

Any owner of land within the territory proposed to be reorganized may file an official protest. Such protest must be made in writing and submitted to the LAFCO office prior to the conclusion of the hearing. The written protest must include your name, address, address of the land owned within the affected area if different from your residence, Assessor Parcel Number and LAFCO number. The written protest must be dated. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax.

Any registered voter residing within the territory proposed to be reorganized may file an official protest. Such protest must be made in writing and submitted to the LAFCO office prior to the conclusion of the hearing. The written protest must include your name and address as they appear on the affidavit of registration and the LAFCO number. The written protest must be dated. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax.
