There are no new or additional special taxes, assessment or fees as a result of this action.

3. Will the territory be relieved of any existing special taxes, assessments, district charges or fees required by the agencies to be detached?

The San Bernardino County Consolidated Fire District has each form of these fees within the boundaries that it currently manages. There are six special taxes that were voted on post Proposition 13 as a special tax (Lake Arrowhead-Paramedic, Highland-Paramedic, Yucaipa-Paramedic, El Mirage-Fire, Red Mountain-Fire, and Windy Acres-Fire). These areas will be dissolved and re-established as an Improvement District within the new fire department reorganization. Contractual agreements between the cities and the fire department (Fontana Redevelopment Area (RDA), Grand Terrace RDA, and Yucca Valley RDA) will need to be reassigned to the new fire department which relate to RDA's with no planned adjustment to the contract. All fees collected for services provided will be reassigned to the new fire department and continue for the services provided. These fees relate to fire protection planning, ambulance billing, cost recovery, hazardous waste collections and other related services. There will be no changes to any existing special taxes, assessments, charges, or fees as a result of this reorganization of the San Bernardino County Consolidated Fire District.

4. Provide a description of how the proposed change will assist the annexing agency in achieving its fair share of regional housing needs as determined by SCAG.


