**Re: LAFCO 3050 (Arrowhead Springs Reorganization/Annexation No. 360); and
LAFCO 3067-A -3067 F (Annexation No. 361)**

Dear Ms. Rollings-McDonald:

This letter is to request that the above cited annexations set to be heard by the LAFCO Commission on September 16, 2009 be continued until the November 18, 2009 Meeting. As you are aware, the City has requested several extensions since the application for LAFCO 3067 A-F was filed in January 2006. Because this application is contingent upon the annexation of Arrowhead Springs, the extensions were requested to allow time for Campus Crusade to address LAFCO's water and wastewater concerns.

The City of San Bernardino's Water Department has successfully negotiated an agreement with Campus Crusade and Arrowhead Springs Corporation regarding a provision of service for the Arrowhead Springs Specific Plan Project Area, and the Water Department Board approved the agreement on July 21, 2009 (attached). It is my understanding that this agreement satisfies LAFCO's concerns and the annexation process is ready to move forward.

Subsequent to City's filing in January of 2006, the LAFCO Commission took action to modify the six areas proposed to be annexed to include substantially larger portions (from 1100 acres to 3300 acres). Staff is in the process of re-evaluating the plan for service to the six areas, as well as the estimated revenue. The additional time is being requested to allow for completion of this analysis. The new plan for services for the six islands will be provided to LAFCO staff no later than September 21, 2009.
