I am disappointed that the annexation consideration by LAFCO will be continued from its scheduled September 16, 2009 meeting to November. However, Campus Crusade supports the City in their request for a continuance. Although Campus Crusade supports completing this annexation as soon as possible, we understand the City's issues regarding the Island annexations and remain supportive of the City and their desire to complete this annexation.

It is my understanding that Campus Crusade staff and our consultants have successfully completed all necessary tasks and submittals regarding Arrowhead Springs required for the City of San Bernardino to complete the application for annexation. The San Bernardino Water Board approved the agreement between Campus Crusade and the Water Department on July 21, 2009 and the agreements are currently being executed.

I look forward to notification from LAFCO for the final consideration of this annexation in November. As you know, this has been a very long and complicated process and remains one of the last hurdles in the way of moving forward with future development of Arrowhead Springs.
