A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUCAIPA, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION TO TAKE PROCEEDINGS FOR A SPHERE OF INFLUENCE REVIEW (EXPANSION) FOR THE CITY OF YUCAIPA, AND A REORGANIZATION TO INCLUDE ANNEXATIONS TO THE CITY OF YUCAIPA, THE YUCAIPA VALLEY WATER DISTRICT AND THE SAN BERNARDINO VALLEY MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT, AND DETACHMENTS FROM THE SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, ITS VALLEY SERVICE ZONE AND SERVICE ZONE PM-3, COUNTY SERVICE AREA 63, AND COUNTY SERVICE AREA 70 (ANNEXATION NO. 5)

WHEREAS, the City of Yucaipa desires to initiate proceedings pursuant to the Cortese-Knox Local Government Reorganization Act of 1985, Division 3, commencing with Section 56000 of the California Government Code, for the sphere of influence expansion and reorganization identified as Annexation No. 5; and

WHEREAS, the territory proposed to be annexed is uninhabited, and a description of the boundaries of the territory is set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, this proposal also requires an expansion of the sphere of influence for the City of Yucaipa that will not conflict with any sphere of influence; and

WHEREAS, no terms and conditions have been identified for the annexation outside the standard conditions required by LAFCO; and


WHEREAS, the reasons for this proposed annexation are to provide more logical service boundaries and services.



This Resolution of Application is adopted and approved by the City Council, and the Local Agency Formation Commission of San Bernardino County is hereby requested to take proceedings for the sphere of influence review and the proposed reorganization as described in Exhibit "A", according to the terms and conditions stated above and in the manner provided by the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000.
