9. Municipal Service Review for the Communities of Yermo, Daggett and Newberry Springs, and the following Sphere of Influence Update/Amendment Reviews: **(continued from May 20, 2009)**
 - A. Consideration of: (1) CEQA Statutory Exemption for LAFCO 3008; and (2) LAFCO 3008 – Service Review and Sphere of Influence Update for Yermo CSD;
 - B. Consideration of: (1) CEQA Statutory Exemption for LAFCO 3045; and (2) 3045 – Service Review and Sphere of Influence Update for Daggett CSD;
 - C. Consideration of: (1) CEQA Statutory Exemption for LAFCO 3046; and (2) LAFCO 3046 – Service Review and Sphere of Influence Update for Newberry CSD

The overall service review and sphere study area encompasses approximately 226 square miles and is located in the north desert portion of the County and includes the communities commonly known as Daggett, Harvard, Newberry Springs and Yermo. The area is generally bordered by a combination of section lines and the City of Barstow boundary and sphere on the west which includes territory west of Fort Irwin and Ord Mountain Roads; a combination of section lines and half-section lines on the north; a combination of section lines and Manix Road on the east which includes territories one mile east of Troy Dry Lake; and a combination of the City of Barstow boundaries and section lines on the south which includes area south of Interstate 40 and a small


portion of the City of Barstow sphere of influence. The map below outlines the existing boundaries and sphere of influence of the Daggett, Newberry and Yermo Community Services Districts (CSD):



Sphere amendments proposed for Commission review are:

- 1) Discussion of the potential for sphere of influence consolidations.
 - 2) Expansion of the Daggett CSD sphere of influence to include the territory located in Section 13 of T09N01W generally west of the Daggett CSD, and north, east, and south of the City of Barstow (Marine Corps Nebo Annex).
 - 3) Expansion of the Yermo CSD sphere of influence to include the territory located in Sections 2 and 11 of T09N, R01E generally north of Daggett CSD, east of the Marine Corps Yermo Annex, and south and west of Yermo CSD.
 - 4) Expansion of the Yermo CSD sphere of influence to include two separate areas located in Sections 16, 17, 20, 21, AND 24 of T10N, R01E and Sections 18, 19, 20 of T10N, R02E. The area is generally located south of the Calico Mountains and west, north, and west of Yermo CSD.
10. Consideration of: (1) CEQA Statutory Exemption for LAFCO 3008A; and (2) LAFCO 3008A – Activation of Water Powers for Yermo Community Services District **(continued from May 20, 2009)**

The Yermo Community Services District is proposing to activate its latent water powers. Authorization of the function and service will be for the entirety of the District while service is anticipated to be initially limited to within the boundaries of its Water Service Zone created on February 17, 2009, which includes the territory of the existing Yermo Water Company, a private water provider. As defined by Resolution No. 1, 2009 the Yermo CSD Water Service Zone is generally bordered by the Mojave River on the south (excluding the area of the Union Pacific Water System [currently undefined]), a boundary line one-half mile west of Frontier Avenue on the west, Interstate 15 on the north, and a boundary line one-half mile east of Seventh Street on the east. As shown on the map below it includes the area of the existing Yermo Water Company as well as other territory.
