The proposed sphere expansion for County Service Area 42, a combination of proposals identified as LAFCO 3094 and LAFCO 3115, comprises approximately 20.66+/- acres and is generally located east of the Mojave River and north of the City of Victorville, within the community of Oro Grande. The sphere of influence study area is generally located west of the existing boundary of County Service Area 42, north of Mill Street, east and south of parcel boundaries. The sphere amendment is located east and west of National Trails Highway (old Route 66).

6.   Consideration of: (1) CEQA Statutory Exemption for LAFCO 3116; and (2) LAFCO 3116 – Annexation to County Service Area 42 (Oro Grande)

The proposed annexation area encompasses approximately 16.98+/- acres and is generally located east of the Mojave River and north of the City of Victorville, within the community of Oro Grande. The area is generally bordered by a combination of the National Trails Highway right-of-way and parcel boundaries (portion of existing CSA 42 boundaries) on the north, parcel boundaries (existing CSA 42 boundaries) on the east and south, and a combination of the National Trails Highway right-of-way and parcel boundaries on the west.
