Consideration of: (1) Final Environmental Impact Report Adopted by City of San Bernardino for the San Bernardino General Plan Update and Associated Specific Plans (SCH No. 2004111132), as CEQA Responsible Agency LAFCO 3050; (2) Adoption of Findings of Fact and Statement of Overriding Considerations; (3) Review of Addendum Prepared by LAFCO Environmental Consultant to Address Expansion of the Boundary to include CALTRANS Right-of-Way Area along State Route 18 and Two (2) Additional Parcels as a CEQA Lead Agency for LAFCO 3050; and (4) LAFCO 3050 – Reorganization to Include City of San Bernardino Annexation No. 360 and Detachments from the San Bernardino County Fire Protection District and its Valley Service Zone, and County Service Area 70 (Arrowhead Springs Specific Plan Area) (continued from the September 16, 2009 Hearing)

The reorganization area consists of two separate areas totaling approximately 1,590+/- acres located in the City of San Bernardino's northern sphere of influence. The reorganization area includes the historic Arrowhead Springs Hotel and its surrounding area. Area 1 encompasses approximately 1,298+/- acres generally located north of the City of San Bernardino boundaries, east of State Route 18. The expansion for Area 1 is Assessor Parcel Number 0270-111-01. Area 2 encompasses approximately 292+/- acres generally located east and west of State Route 18 in the Old Waterman Canyon area. The expansion for Area 2 includes Assessor Parcel Number 0270-011-01 and the CALTRANS Right-of-Way Area along State Route 18.

In its deliberations, the Commission may make appropriate changes incidental to the above-listed proposal.

Current law and Commission policy require the publishing of staff reports prior to the public hearing. These reports contain technical findings, comments, and recommendations of staff. The staff recommendation may be accepted or rejected by the Commission after its own analysis and consideration of public testimony.

If you challenge any decision regarding the above proposal in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the LAFCO staff office at, or prior to, the public hearing.

A person with a disability may contact the LAFCO office at (909) 383-9900 at least 72-hours before the scheduled meeting to request receipt of an agenda in an alternative format or to request disability-related accommodations, including auxiliary aids or services, in order to participate in the public meeting. Later requests will be accommodated to the extent feasible.
