

**NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING FOR LAFCO 3093 - Reorganization to Include
City of Redlands Annexation Nos. 88 and 89 and Detachment from
County Service Area 70 Improvement Zone P-7 (Wabash Industrial Park)**

Notice is hereby given that a Protest Hearing will be held by the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) of San Bernardino County. The hearing will be held in the LAFCO office located at 215 N. "D" St., Suite 204, San Bernardino, California 92415-0490, on July 17, 2008 at 10:00 a.m., to hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which are made, presented, or filed regarding LAFCO 3093.

The annexation area encompasses approximately 27.88+/- acres, generally bordered by Wabash Avenue on the west (existing City boundary), Naples Avenue on the north (portion of existing City boundary) and a combination of Jasper Road and the San Bernardino Associated Governments property (formerly the BNSF Railroad) on the east and south, within the City of Redlands' eastern sphere of influence, within the community of Mentone. The reorganization area is more specifically described in the legal description and map available for review in the LAFCO office located at the above address.

Proceedings for this reorganization were initiated by property owner petition and submitted to LAFCO. This proposal has been assigned the short-form designation of LAFCO 3093.

The proposed terms and conditions for this reorganization are set forth in LAFCO Resolution No. 3004 adopted by the Commission on May 21, 2008, which is available for review in the LAFCO office, located at the above address.

The reason for this proposal, as provided by the applicant, is:

To acquire water and sewer service from the City of Redlands for the development of APN 0298-052-09 and APN 0298-061-20.

Any owner of land within the territory proposed to be reorganized may file an official protest. Such protest must be made in writing and submitted to the LAFCO office prior to the conclusion of the hearing. The written protest must include your name, address, address of the land owned within the affected area if different from your residence, Assessor Parcel Number and LAFCO number. The written protest must be dated. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax.

LAFCO policy requires that all applications for jurisdictional changes include disclosure of campaign contributions in excess of \$1,000. The entire policy and applicable forms to report campaign expenditures are available on LAFCO's website at www.sbclafco.org. Any forms received will be posted on the LAFCO website for public viewing with addresses and phone numbers redacted.
