

NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING FOR LAFCO 3071 - DISSOLUTION OF THE VICTORVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT (SUBSIDIARY DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF VICTORVILLE)

Notice is hereby given that a Protest Hearing will be held by the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) of San Bernardino County. The hearing will be held in the LAFCO office located at 215 N. "D" St., Suite 204, San Bernardino, California 92415-0490, on September 11, 2008 at 10:00 a.m., to hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which are made, presented, or filed regarding LAFCO 3071.

The dissolution area consists of 73.9 square miles, approximately 73.8 square miles of which are within the corporate boundaries of the City of Victorville.

Proceedings for this dissolution were initiated by the City of Victorville and submitted to LAFCO. This proposal has been assigned the short-form designation of LAFCO 3071.

The proposed terms and conditions for this dissolution are set forth in LAFCO Resolution No. 3011 adopted by the Commission on July 16, 2008, which is available for review in the LAFCO office.

The reason for this proposal is to eliminate a special district previously established as a subsidiary district of the City of Victorville and to fully integrate its funding mechanisms and functions with the City of Victorville.

Any owner of land within the territory of the special district to be dissolved may file an official protest. Such protest must be made in writing and submitted to the LAFCO office prior to the conclusion of the hearing. The written protest must include your name, address, address of the land owned within the affected area if different from your residence, Assessor Parcel Number and LAFCO number. The written protest must be dated. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax.

Any registered voter residing within the territory of the special district to be dissolved may file an official protest. Such protest must be made in writing and submitted to the LAFCO office prior to the conclusion of the hearing. The written protest must include your name and address as they appear on the affidavit of registration and the LAFCO number. The written protest must be dated. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax.

LAFCO policy requires that all applications for jurisdictional changes include disclosure of campaign contributions in excess of \$1,000. The entire policy and applicable forms to report campaign expenditures are available on LAFCO's website at www.sbclafco.org/campaign_disclosure. Any forms received will be posted on the LAFCO website for public viewing with addresses and phone numbers redacted.
