All of those portions in the unincorporated territory of the County of San Bernardino, State of California, lying within the following described boundaries:

**Area 1:**

A parcel of unincorporated land lying within the boundaries of the City of San Bernardino, County of San Bernardino, State of California, described as follows:

**Beginning** at the intersection of the centerline of Lynwood Drive and Harrison Street, said point being on the existing boundary of the City of San Bernardino;

Thence following along said existing boundary, through its various courses, in a generally northerly, easterly, northerly, easterly, southeasterly, easterly, southerly, westerly, southerly, easterly, southerly, easterly, southerly, and westerly direction to the **Point of Beginning**.

This area contains approximately 193.4 acres, more or less.

**Area 2:**

A parcel of unincorporated land lying within the boundaries of the City of San Bernardino, County of San Bernardino, State of California, described as follows:

**Beginning** at the intersection of the centerline of Del Rosa Avenue and Lynwood Drive, said point being also on the existing boundary of the City of San Bernardino;

Thence following along said existing boundary, through its various courses, in a generally northerly, easterly, northerly, westerly, northerly, easterly, southeasterly, southerly, easterly, southerly, westerly, southerly, westerly, southerly, westerly and northerly direction to the **Point of Beginning**.

This area contains approximately 362.0 acres, more or less.

### Area 3:

A parcel of unincorporated land lying within the boundaries of the City of San Bernardino, County of San Bernardino, State of California, described as follows:

**Beginning** at the intersection of the centerline of Sterling Avenue and Lynwood Drive, said point being also on the existing boundary of the City of San Bernardino;

Thence following along said existing city boundary, through its various courses, in a generally easterly, northerly, easterly, southerly, easterly, northerly, easterly, southerly, easterly, southerly, westerly, northerly, westerly, northerly, southeasterly, northerly, westerly, southerly, westerly, northeasterly, northerly, southeasterly, southerly, easterly and northerly direction to the **Point of Beginning**.

This area contains approximately 316.6 acres, more or less.

### Area 4:

A parcel of unincorporated land lying within the boundaries of the City of San Bernardino, County of San Bernardino, State of California, described as follows:

**Beginning** at the intersection of the centerline of Sterling Avenue and Highland Avenue, said point being also on the existing boundary of the City of San Bernardino;

1. Thence following along said existing boundary, through its various courses, in a generally southerly direction to existing boundary of the City of Highland;
2. Thence leaving said existing boundary of the City of San Bernardino and continuing along the existing boundary of the City of Highland, through its various courses, in a generally westerly and southerly direction to a point on the existing boundary of the City of San Bernardino;
3. Thence leaving the existing boundary of the City of Highland and continuing along the existing boundary of the City of San Bernardino, through its various courses, in a generally westerly, northerly, easterly, northerly, westerly, northerly, easterly, southerly, easterly, southerly, northeasterly, southerly, easterly, northerly, easterly, southerly, easterly, northerly, and easterly direction to the **Point of Beginning**.

This area contains approximately 418.2 acres, more or less.

**Area 5:**

A parcel of unincorporated land lying within the boundaries of the City of San Bernardino, County of San Bernardino, State of California, described as follows:

**Beginning** at the intersection of the centerline of Waterman Avenue and 3rd Street, said point being also the existing boundary of the City of San Bernardino;


1. Thence following along said existing boundary, through it's various courses, in a generally northerly, easterly, northeasterly, southerly, westerly, southwesterly, easterly, southerly, easterly, northerly and easterly direction to the existing boundary of the City of Highland;
2. Thence leaving said existing city boundary of the City of San Bernardino and continuing along the existing boundary of the City of Highland, through its various courses, in a generally southerly direction to the existing boundary of said City of San Bernardino;
3. Thence leaving said existing City of Highland and continuing along the existing boundary of the City of San Bernardino in a generally westerly direction to the **Point of Beginning**.

This area contains approximately 273.00 acres, more or less.

The total area of these parcels contains 1563.2 acres, more or less.
