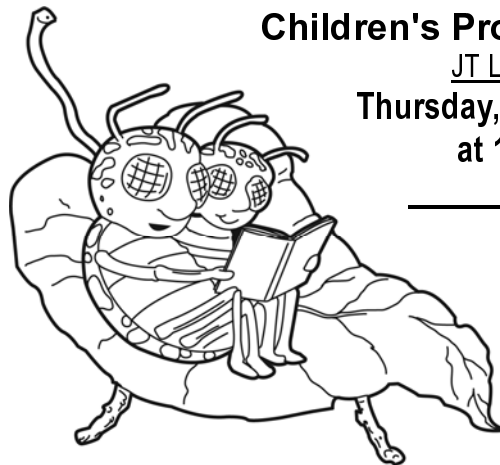

# Summer Reading Program Guidelines

## How To Sign Up

Welcome to the Joshua Tree Branch Library's **Catch the Reading Bug@ Your Library**  
**2008 Summer Reading Program** for Grades Pre-K- 6th

- \* You may register beginning **Monday, June 16** during regular library hours.
- \* Readers may begin checking out books to be entered in their reading logs on **Monday, June 16**.
- \* At sign-up you will receive: a reading log, two prize drawing tickets and a flyer with the program guidelines and performance schedule.

## Please note the following guidelines:

- \* Books **must** be checked out of the Joshua Tree Library for at least 1 day to be entered in your log.
- \* Rewards will be given as long as supplies last. Alternate rewards may be given.
- \* Parents may read to younger children and enter their books in the reading log.
- \* Audio books may be counted as 1 book.

## How To Earn Rewards For Participating

You will earn an incentive award and two tickets for the prize drawing for each 10 books read up to 70 books.

### Awards are as follows:

**10 Books Read:** Book bag, pencil, & book mark

**20 Books Read:** Bug notepad & Carrow's certificate

**30 Books Read:** Windup ladybug & Circle K Icee certificate

**40 Books Read:** Cube puzzle and Sizzler certificate

**50 Books Read:** Grow spider and Jack-In-The-Box certificate

**60 Books Read:** Water bottle & Del Taco certificate

**70 Books Read:** Pizza Hut certificate

*\*Incentives may be claimed any time during regular business hours.\**

**Note to Parents:** *Please keep in mind that the Summer Reading Program is a way to keep your child engaged in reading throughout the summer. Maintaining your child reading skills will greatly benefit them when they return to school in the Fall. We recommended you plan your child's reading and the earning of incentives to last throughout the summer. Remember, make reading a fun family activity!*

## Special Activities

There will be one activity page per week of the program. Children may earn two tickets for each activity page completed. Children will receive two tickets to the prize drawing when they attend a Summer Reading Program performance.

## Guidelines for Program Days

Our audience area is small. Please allow children to be seated first and nearest the front of the audience area.

Parents and caregivers are welcome on a space available basis. Please place chairs at the back of the audience area only. Please no strollers in the audience area.

Please take children out of the audience area if they are unable to sit quietly during the performance. When returning please be seated at the rear of the audience.

Please remain at the library while your child is attending Summer Reading Program performances.

Please come into the library early on program days. The branch opens at 10:00 a.m. and this will allow you and your child time to chose books, claim incentives and be seated in time for the performance at 11:00 a.m.

Most of all enjoy the program! Please let the staff or an SRP volunteer know if there is anything we can do to help you or your child better enjoy the library and the program.

# Joshua Tree Branch Summer Reading Program Guidelines



## HOW TO SIGN UP

- \* You may register beginning **Monday June 16<sup>th</sup>** during regular library hours.
- \* Readers may begin checking out books to be entered in their reading logs on **Monday June 16**.
- \* At sign-up you will receive: a bookmark, reading log, two prize drawing tickets and a flyer with the program guidelines.

## Please note the following guidelines:

- \* Books **must** be checked out of the Joshua Tree Library for at least 1 day to be entered in your log.
- \* Rewards will be given as long as supplies last. Alternate rewards may be given.
- \* YA audio books may be counted as 100 pages.

## HOW TO EARN REWARDS FOR PARTICIPATING

You will earn an incentive award and two tickets for the prize drawing beginning at the first 200 pages read, and then for each additional 150 pages read, up to 1100 pages.

### Awards are as follows:

- 200 Pages Read:** Book bag, book mark and mood pencil
- 350 Pages Read:** Color Changing Cup and Jack-In-The-Box certificate
- 500 Pages Read:** Sticky Notes Pad and Circle K soda certificate
