



# The Arrest of Wyatt Earp

Organized claim-jumping at Searles Lake in 1910 led to the arrest of Wyatt Earp at Slate Range City. The start of the little-remembered “Potash Wars” eventually led to the founding of Trona and the industrial development of Searles Valley. Russell Kaldenberg will tell the tale in “The Arrest of Wyatt Earp at Slate Range City and the Beginning of the Potash Wars.”



Russell Kaldenberg is a principal for ASM Affiliates, a cultural resources management firm, managing their Rocky Mountain Division in Cheyenne, Wyoming. He retired from federal service as the Base Archaeologist for China Lake Naval Air Weapons Station and spent most of his career with the Bureau of Land Management in California. He received his Masters Degree in Anthropology from San Diego State University and is on the Board of Directors for the Mojave Desert Heritage and Cultural Association in Goffs, California.
