


TalkShops at the Museum

Six Legs or Eight: Illustrating Arthropods

Have you ever looked closely at an insect or a spider? We mean a really, really close look? Scientific illustrators do just that to capture the details of their subject. Scientific illustrations are found in field guides, encyclopedias, magazines and journals, and are used by scientists, collectors, researchers, and educators. Getting the details is important, and this TalkShop is the place to learn how it happens.

Chad Lynde, San Bernardino County Museum education specialist, will introduce the distinctive characteristics of some of the museum's specimens, both live and preserved. Then illustrator Katura Reynolds will guide participants through the process of up-close observation and drawing techniques.



Chad has been herding critters at the Exploration Station for more than a decade. His deft touch with cockroaches and walking sticks never fails to thrill museum visitors. He acquired two degrees in art and minored in zoology at California State University, Fullerton.



Katura earned a BA in art and a graduate certificate in science illustration at the University of California, Santa Cruz. She completed two internships at the Smithsonian Institute's National Museum of Natural History, and has since done illustrations for various scientific publications and museum exhibits.

A TalkShop is a topic-related talk from a subject expert using specimens or artifacts, followed by an artist-led master class. TalkShops are intended for adults and children 13 and older. No previous art experience or skills are required. Participation in a TalkShop is included with your prepaid museum admission. Admission is free for Museum Association members, but **pre-registration is required**. We will send you a reservation confirmation. **Register no later than October 26.**
