- Participate in hands-on activities and interactive lessons in history, anthropology, forensics, geology, paleontology, and engineering
- Play outdoor games and establish life-long friendships
- Develop cooperative and team building skills

WEEKLY CAMP THEMES, DATE AND TIMES INCLUDE:

Session One: Exploring STEM - June 28-July 1, 9:00am-12:30pm

Develop problem solving skills and explore the concepts of building and construction through hands-on exploration and design, and engage in friendly engineering competitions such as the Pipe Cleaner Challenge and Build a Solar Robot. Working in cooperative groups, and guided by the museum's exhibition team campers create a unique museum exhibit.

Session Two: Exploring Forensics - July 5-8, 9:00am-12:30pm

Find out whodunit by solving a mock crime at the museum! A special guest expert in forensic science leads campers through the process of crime investigation and hands-on activities to leave a lasting impression.

Session Three: Exploring Geology and Paleontology - July 12-15, 9:00am-12:30pm

Become an expert paleontologist by engaging in a mock dig. Campers will discover the wonders under the surface of the earth, exploring the formation of rocks and digging for gems.

Session Four: Exploring History and Anthropology - July 19-22, 9:00am-12:30pm

Discover people of the past in San Bernardino County through historical activities like gold panning and the art of flint knapping. The curators of history and anthropology lead campers through a reenactment of early western living.

Session Five: Exploring Animals - July 26-29, 9:00am-12:30pm

Get up close with animals, reptiles and bugs! Campers will participate in fun, interactive explorations of animal habitats and adaptations, and encounters at the Museum's Exploration Station. Campers will also have a chance to learn about exotic animals with a special guest visit from the Wild Wonders Animal Zoo.

Fees listed above are per week. If paying by cash, please pay at Museum Front Desk, please do not send cash through the mail, LIMITED SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE BY APPLICATION, contact staff for details. All materials and activities are included in cost, which must be received at the Museum by 4 p.m. on the deadline stated above. Camper is NOT enrolled in camp until registration form and full payment are received at the Museum. Sorry, we cannot "hold" spaces for campers, and space is limited. All sessions are expected to fill.

Due to the activities in these programs, campers must have completed 1st grade and be from 7-10 years of age. Campers must bring a snack and water bottle each day. Shoes must be closed toe and clothing should be appropriate for physical activities and art making. The Museum staff are not responsible for personal belongings of campers. Camper must exhibit appropriate behavior at the Museum. The camper's medical insurance is the primary source of payment for any accident, injury, or illness arising during Museum camp.

CANCELLATION/CHANGE/REFUND POLICY: Campers may change session based on space availability. Full refund of fees may be made if withdrawal is requested (10) days before camp begins. Six (6) to (10) days before camp begins, a refund of 75% of the fees may be made. Camp registration payment is nonrefundable five (5) or fewer days prior to camp. The Museum reserves the right to cancel a camp session. In case of cancellation, campers will be notified in advance and full refunds will be made.
