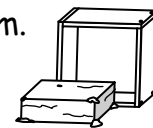
Saturday, October 3: Take It Apart Day!

Saturday, October 10: Adobe Day at the Museum!



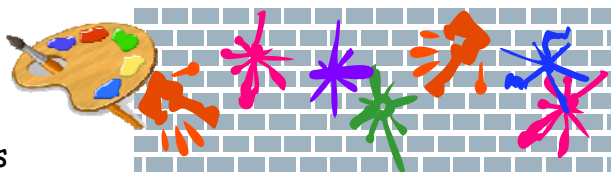
