

# 29th Annual Wildlife Art Festival

## Artisan Registration

November 19 & 20, 2011

### San Bernardino County Museum

The Wildlife Art Festival (WAF) returns for its 29th year to the San Bernardino County Museum on November 19 and 20, 2011. The festival features wildlife and nature artists; art sales; the first West Coast exhibition of the top entries in the Federal Duck Stamp Competition; and 2,000 visitors from all over southern California.

You are invited to apply for one of the twenty spaces available for nature-inspired arts and craft and native plants artisans and vendors at the San Bernardino County Museum, 2024 Orange Tree Lane, Redlands, CA. Artisans, along with family fun activities, will be featured in the museum's courtyard.

## Set-Up and Schedule

The Festival is open to the public from 9 am to 5 pm Saturday and 9 am to 4 pm Sunday. Artisans may set up on Saturday, November 19, beginning at 7:30 am. Items may be locked in the museum overnight on Saturday (at your own risk). Take-down begins on Sunday after 4 pm. Artisans will be assigned a 10x10 space in the museum courtyard. If you haven't seen our recently remolded courtyard, please feel free to stop by for a visit prior to the show.

- Artisans must provide their own table and chairs; shade/rain structure; and electrical extension cords (if needed). Limited electrical availability.
- Artisans are responsible for their own display materials.
- Artisans are responsible for the safety and security of their property.
- In case of heavy rain, courtyard activities may be cancelled.



# Conditions for Artisan and Vendor Participation

Vendors and artisans are required to exhibit products that demonstrate a relationship with nature, inform about nature and its processes, and/or utilize reclaimed, recycled, or natural materials, and above all honor nature in artistic, aesthetic ways.

In lieu of the \$100 vendor fee, each participant may donate a gift basket (minimum value \$100) for our silent auction at “An Evening with the Artists” on Friday, November 18. You will receive two complimentary tickets to attend, although attendance is not mandatory. Gift Baskets or \$100 vendor fee must be received on or before Monday, November 7, 2011.

All products offered for sale during the festival are subject to a 30% commission paid to the San Bernardino County Museum Association (SBCMA). All artisans and vendors will conduct their own sales transactions. All sales must be recorded in SBCMA receipt book (provided at event). Sales reconciliation will be conducted at the close of each festival day. Vendor or artisan is responsible for California state sales tax.

All vendors and artisans agree to indemnify, defend, and hold the San Bernardino County, the San Bernardino County Museum (Museum), and the SBCMA and all of their agents harmless against any third party claims arising from the event.

San Bernardino County Museum and SBCMA assume no liability with respect to any property, of any kind, placed upon the premises by the vendor or artisan.

San Bernardino County, the Museum, SBCMA, or any event sponsors are not responsible for accidents or stolen items.
