Merit Badge Workshops at the San Bernardino County Museum for Cubs, Webelos, and Boy Scouts

Cubs & Webelos

Webelos Geology: Sunday, April 22, 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. Explore rocks, minerals, and fossils using authentic specimens and replicas. Designed especially for Webelos, requirements are met for the Geologist Activity Badge and the Academic Belt Loop and Pin.

Wolf Cubs Native American Lore: May 12, 2012. 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. In this program, Wolf Cubs will explore Indian material culture by creating their own tool, clothing, and a musical instrument. Build on boys' fascination with prehistory by giving them connections to the First Nations People.

Bear Cubs Native American Life: May 12, 2012. 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. In this hands-on workshop, Bears will learn about local Indian cultures. Cubs will discover how Indian people once lived and explore their material culture. Scouts will also make and play Indian games and build a model of a traditional house!

COST for Cub and Webelo workshops: \$13 per Scout; parents and siblings are \$10 each (includes Museum admission on the day of the workshop); children 4 and under are free. Boy Scouts

Indian Lore Merit Badge: April 14, 2012, 3 to 6 p.m. (Cost is \$22.00 per Scout) Scouts will step back through time, exploring the interesting material culture of local California Indian peoples. This workshop guides Scouts through their merit badge requirements with ease, using authentic California Indian exhibits, games, and hands-on replicas. Don't miss out on this great opportunity to learn about the first Californians!

Bird Study Merit Badge May 5, 2012, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Cost is \$38.00 per Scout) During this day-long workshop, Scouts will learn to identify birds by both sight and sound. You will become familiar with bird habitats and environmental influences as well as anatomy, bird calls, and field guide use. This workshop includes van transportation to a nearby birding hot-spot to find local bird species. Registered boys must travel with the group in the van. Participants should bring lunch, water, a snack, and dress appropriately for an easy hike. Bring binoculars if you have them; some binoculars will be made available during the workshop. Space is limited for this workshop.

Parents are welcome to participate, but workshops are **not** appropriate for siblings. Workshops are led by a Certified Badge Counselor. Boys must bring a Blue Card signed by their Scoutmaster.
