Competition Rules

1. Each scrapbook or poster must be accompanied by an **Entry Form**. Fill out the entry form completely. PAPERCLIP the form on the OUTSIDE front cover of your class scrapbook, or on the BACK of your poster.
2. Entries may be designed in a variety of media. See Materials and Media Ideas pages in this guide for more details. Whatever the medium is, books must lie flat when opened, be easy to transport, and stay together during judging. Posters must be 2D with all elements securely fastened, as they will be hung vertically for display.
3. Entries **must be received by 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 8**. If you plan to mail your entry, be sure to leave enough lead time, and wrap it securely. The Museum is NOT responsible for posted entries that arrive late! Mail to:

4. Scrapbooks and posters may be picked up from the Museum during regular business hours beginning November 29, at 3:00 p.m. Entries will be exhibited through Sunday November 27.
5. If you wish us to return your scrapbook or poster by mail after the Wildlife Art Festival, be sure you enclose a cashier's or personal check for \$15 payable to: San Bernardino County Museum.
6. Scrapbooks and posters not claimed by December 2 will become the property of the San Bernardino County Museum.
7. Awards ceremony will be on **Saturday, November 19 at 2:00 p.m.** All participating families, teachers, students and students' family members will be admitted free beginning at 12:00 noon that day. Teachers and families will receive an invitation to the awards ceremony. Individuals and families need the invitation to gain entry, and only those family members whose names appeared on the poster entry will be admitted free. Students and their families may announce their school's and teacher's names for entry. Teachers must reproduce the invitation for all of their students to take home.
8. All competition work must be original, and done by the students, individuals and family members. Any scrapbook or poster containing plagiarized written or illustrated work will be disqualified. The decision of the judges in this matter is final.
