Tiger Cubs

Past Life and Animals

This package program includes a trip to the museum and three electives about animals. Your Tiger Cubs will practice the core value of respect as they explore the past, learn to ask questions, and witness their elders' experiences. In the animals section of the day, Cubs learn about animal groups, where they live, and what foods they eat. Cubs will also investigate proper pet care procedures in our Exploration Station live animal gallery!



Wolf Cubs

Native American Lore

In this program, Wolf Cubs will explore Indian material culture by creating their own tool, clothing, and a musical instrument. Build on boys' fascination with prehistory by giving them connections to the First Nations People.



Webelo Scouts

Geologist Badge Workshop

This great program will have your Webelos looking at rocks in a whole new way! Boys will explore rocks, minerals, and fossils using authentic specimens and replicas. Designed especially for Webelos, requirements are met for the Geologist Activity Badge and the Academics Belt Loop and Pin.



Bear Cubs

Native American Life

In this hands-on workshop scouts will learn about local Indian cultures. Bear Cubs will discover how Indian people once lived and explore their material culture. Cubs will also make and play Indian games and build a model of a traditional house!



Wildlife and Garden

In this workshop, Bear Cubs will meet requirements for both achievement 5, Sharing Your World with Wildlife, and the Wildlife Conservation Belt Loop and Pin. Your Cubs will learn about birds and their habitats, talk with an expert about conservation, and explore the concept of extinction. Boys will also visit the Exploration Station live animal gallery. In addition, Cubs will do a community clean-up project that fulfills partial Landscaping requirements.



Space and Stars

This is a fun, multi-activity program that helps your Bear Cubs earn both their Space Badge and Astronomy Academic Belt Loop and Pin. Learn how to use binoculars and star maps with the help of our StarLab. Find common Greek constellations and compare them to those of other cultures. Cubs will make their own telescopes and build a model of a space shuttle to take home. Scouts will also discover the mysteries of our solar system.



Naturalist Badge Workshop

This exciting, hands-on program uses museum specimens, activities, and up-close encounters with live animals to help your Webelos explore and understand the wildlife around them. By completing this fun workshop, they will earn their Naturalist Activity Badge and their Wildlife Conservation Academics Belt Loop and Pin.
