Grandma's Attic

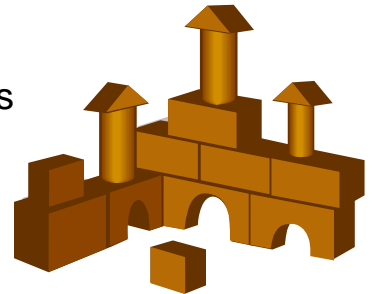

The cost for children of Museum Association members will be \$65.00 for Grandma's Attic camp. Children of non-members will be \$75.00 for Grandma's Attic camp. One accompanying adult for up to three (3) children is free and must stay with child(ren) during camp hours. All materials and activities are included in the cost, which needs to be received at the Museum by 4 p.m. on Friday, June 19, 2009. Camper is NOT enrolled in camp until this registration form and the full payment are received at the Museum. Sorry, but we cannot "hold" spaces for campers, and space is limited.

Due to the activities in these programs, campers must be 4 to 7 years of age. Campers may bring a water bottle each day. Shoes must be close-toed and clothing should be appropriate for physical activities for all children and accompanying adults. The Museum and staff are not responsible for personal belongings of campers. Campers must exhibit appropriate behavior at the Museum. The camper's medical insurance is the primary source of payment for any accident, injury, or illness arising during Museum camp.

CANCELLATION/CHANGE/REFUND POLICY: Campers may change sessions based on space availability. Full refund of fees may be made if withdrawal is prior to ten (10) days before camp begins. Six (6) to ten (10) days before camp begins, a refund of 75% of the fees may be made. Camp registration payment is nonrefundable five (5) or fewer days prior to camp. The Museum reserves the right to cancel a camp session. In case of cancellation, campers will be notified in advance and full refunds will be made.
