- artists reception and auction 6pm

Saturday, Nov. 20

- festival open 9am to 5pm

Sunday, Nov. 21

- festival open 9am to 4pm • take-down after 4pm

## Media

- All two-dimensional original work, including painting, drawing, pastel, mixed media, collage, photography
- Three-dimensional work including sculpture, carving, ceramics
- Limited-edition prints
- Postcards, stationery, calendars, jewelry and similar materials may be sold
- Artists selected for the festival may show a limited amount (20% or less) of art works that do not depict wildlife and nature.

## Entry

- Artist application (attached) must be completed for consideration
- Send 5 images of your recent work depicting wildlife and nature on a CD
- The CD must be clearly labeled with your name
- Include a list with the title, dimensions, media, and price of each work on the CD

## Copyright

- Work must be the entrant's original work.

## Fees and Commission

- Once your work is accepted, the booth fee is \$150.00
- The Museum Association will retain a 30% commission (before sales tax) for ALL sales at or as a result of the festival.
