Session 5: July 30 to August 3, 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.


Cost: \$155.00 (non-members), \$135.00 (Museum members) per week


Session 2: July 9 to July 13, 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Plenty of free form exploration will complement activities that develop skill in design, technique and aesthetics. Every effort is valued as a product of the artist's creative self. Each day will feature one of the five senses to fuel creativity. Parents and families join campers on Friday afternoon 1:30-2:30 for an **Artists' Reception**, to enjoy the exhibition and create art of their own.

Investigating Animals in the Lab and Field

The cost for children of non-members is \$155.00 per week of camp. The cost for children of Museum Association members is \$135.00 per one week of camp. LIMITED SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE BY APPLICATION. Contact staff for details. All materials and activities are included in the cost, which must be received at the Museum by 4 p.m. on the deadline stated above. Camper is NOT enrolled in camp until registration form and full payment are received at the Museum. Sorry, but we cannot "hold" spaces for campers, and space is limited. All sessions are expected to fill.

Due to the activities in these programs, campers must have completed 1st grade and be from 7 to 12 years old.
Campers must bring a lunch, snack, and water bottle each day. Shoes must be close-toed and clothing should be appropriate for physical activities and art-making. The Museum and staff are not responsible for personal belongings of campers. Campers must exhibit appropriate behavior at the Museum. The camper's medical insurance is the primary source of payment for any accident, injury, or illness arising during Museum camp.

CANCELLATION/CHANGE/REFUND POLICY: Campers may change sessions based on space availability. Full refund of fees may be made if withdrawal is requested prior to ten (10) days before camp begins. Six (6) to ten (10) days before camp begins, a refund of 75% of the fees may be made. Camp registration payment is nonrefundable five (5) or fewer days prior to camp. The Museum reserves the right to cancel a camp session. In case of cancellation, campers will be notified in advance and full refunds will be made.
