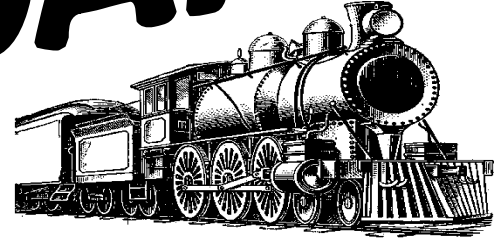


ALL ABOARD! for TRAIN DAYS

Watch as model trains and trolleys steam past country scenery or zoom through tiny cities.

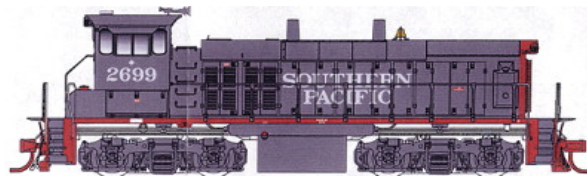
See an expert demonstrate painting techniques to make your train cars look realistic.
