

SUMMER DAY CAMP AT THE SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY MUSEUM

Two sessions for kids ages 7 to 12 and a session for those 4 to 7

INVESTIGATING ANIMALS

Session 1: **July 7 – July 11**, 8:30 AM to 2:30 PM

COST: \$155.00 (NON-MEMBERS), \$135.00 (MUSEUM ASSOCIATION MEMBERS)

Join us as we explore the kingdom of animals. From the microscopic to the gigantic, furred, feathered and fabulous, kids love animals. We'll collect, observe, and study animals and their behavior. Campers will pose scientific questions and conduct research to find answers. They will make and use science field notebooks to help focus observations and collect data, and take home to use as they continue animal studies on their own. And of course, they will pet, cuddle and romp with Exploration Station residents. All Animals—All Week Long! Some camp activities are sponsored in part by Loma Linda University and the National Science Foundation.

During a family party 1:30-2:30 Friday, campers will be interpretive guides, sharing what they learned with family and friends in the Exploration Station Live Animal Gallery.

Here's a special camp session for our friends aged 4-7 and their favorite adult. Children love to explore and pretend, and this camp brims with opportunities for both. Grandma's attic presents big boxes filled with interesting things. Each day, campers will open boxes to reveal what's inside. Old-fashioned fun activities may include finger painting, dress-up, making lemonade, making music, and more. Children and their adults spend excellent quality time playing and exploring together. Limit of 3 children per adult; may be parent, grandparent, other relative or family friend.

Campers will explore the art of making books, collages, painting, color studies, sculpture, photographs, drawing and more. We'll study some great artistic masters and learn unique methods of expression. Plenty of free form exploration will complement activities that develop coordination, technique, as aesthetics. Museum exhibits and live animals will provide forum of study for some activities.

During a family party 1:30-2:30 Friday, campers will be featured in a gallery exhibition of their work.

LIMITED SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE BY APPLICATION. Contact staff for details. All materials and activities are included in the cost, which must be received at the Museum by 4 p.m. on the deadline stated for each sessions above. Camper is NOT enrolled in camp until registration form and full payment are received at the Museum. Sorry, but we cannot "hold" spaces for campers, and space is limited. All sessions are expected to fill. Confirmations will be sent upon receipt of registration. Family and friends are invited to attend Family Parties at 1:30 on Fridays of sessions and 1 and 3.

Due to the nature of activities in sessions 1 and 3, campers must have completed 1st grade and be at least 7 years old. All children ages 4-7 are eligible to attend Grandma's Attic session with an adult. Campers must bring a lunch, snack, and water bottle each day. Grandma's Attic campers do not need lunch. Shoes must be close-toed and clothing should be appropriate for physical activities and art-making. The Museum and staff are not responsible for personal belongings of campers. Campers must exhibit appropriate behavior at the Museum. The camper's medical insurance is the primary source of payment for any accident, injury, or illness arising during Museum camp.

CANCELLATION/CHANGE/REFUND POLICY: Campers may change sessions based on space availability. Full refund of fees may be made if withdrawal is requested prior to ten (10) days before camp begins. Six (6) to ten (10) days before camp begins, a refund of 75% of the fees may be made. Camp registration payment is nonrefundable five (5) or fewer days prior to camp. The Museum reserves the right to cancel a camp session. In case of cancellation, campers will be notified in advance and full refunds will be made.
