Ever wonder what it would have been like to be a Native American hundreds of years ago? Come and experience many of the traditional activities of our local Serrano Indians, including children's toys and games, tool-making, hunting skills, food, clothing, houses, trading, basket-weaving, and stories. By Friday, you will take home a bag full of Serrano toys, tools, and materials that you have made and used during camp. Families are invited to attend a camp "pow-wow" on Friday from 1:30 to 2:30 p.m., when the campers will share some of what they've learned during their week of **Growing Up Serrano**.



## More Animals Around Us

*New animals!*




This 5-day camp will focus on the diversity of animal life in our urban environment. Which animals like to live near humans and which avoid us? Which animals make good pets and which don't? Campers will meet some local residents up close and observe others from a distance. On Friday afternoon, from 1:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m., the families of campers are invited to attend a "Celebration of Animals" to meet and hear about some of their child's favorite new friends from **More Animals Around Us**.



## Playing with History

Session 3: July 11 to July 15, 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Cost: \$155.00 (non-members), \$135.00 (Museum Association members) per week



Did kids have fun 500 years ago? Was it different 200 or even just 100 years ago? Step into the past as we play with history to find out what life was like long ago. Learn about the first people who lived here and the Spanish and American settlers who expanded into this area. Find out how your grandparents lived in the 20<sup>th</sup> century. Everyone will get a chance to make a broom, beat a rug, use old tools, make a real adobe brick, play the "Graces" game, and much more! At the end of the week, campers' families will join us from 1:30 to 2:30 for a "Historic Celebration" to discover the work and play of the past.

## Art and Nature *All new!*

Session 4: July 18 to July 22, 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Cost: \$165.00 (non-members), \$145.00 (Museum members) per week (\$10 extra materials fee included)



Art is all around us, especially in the world of nature! Come explore art using the natural world as your inspiration. Study nature closely, as you learn about color, line, patterns, and more. Nature will be the inspiration, using real materials from nature in some artworks. One special project will be learning to sketch, detail, and color an animal in the Museum. At 1:30 on Friday afternoon, the families of campers are invited to attend an "Artist's Reception" to share art that their young artists have produced during their week of **Art and Nature**.

**Extended Camp option:** Enroll your child for an extended camp experience until 5:30 p.m. Five days of fun from 2:30 to 5:30 p.m., or any portion thereof, for only \$80.00 extra. Extended camp is available for each week of summer day camp.

The cost for children of Museum Association members will be \$135.00 for any one week of camp. **\*\*NOTE:** There is a \$10.00 extra materials fee for **Art and Nature** camp. The cost for children of non-members will be \$155.00 per week of camp. Extended camp (2:30 to 5:30 daily) is \$80.00 for each week of camp. All materials and activities are included in the cost, which must to be received at the Museum by 4 p.m. on the Tuesday that is six (6) days before the camp starts. Camper is NOT enrolled in camp until this registration form and the full payment are received at the Museum. Sorry, but we cannot "hold" spaces for campers, and space is limited.

Due to the activities in these programs, campers must have completed 1<sup>st</sup> grade and be from 7 to 12 years old. Campers must bring a lunch, snack, and water bottle each day. Shoes must be close-toed and clothing should be appropriate for physical activities. The Museum and staff are not responsible for personal belongings of campers. Campers must exhibit appropriate behavior at the Museum. The camper's medical insurance is the primary source of payment for any accident, injury, or illness arising during Museum camp.

**CANCELLATION/CHANGE/REFUND POLICY:** Campers may change sessions based on space availability. Full refund of fees may be made if withdrawal is prior to ten (10) days before camp begins. Six (6) to ten (10) days before camp begins, a refund of 75% of the fees may be made. Camp registration payment is nonrefundable five (5) or fewer days prior to camp. The Museum reserves the right to cancel a camp session. In case of cancellation, campers will be notified in advance and full refunds will be made.
