**SUBJECT: HAVE YOU RETURNED YOUR VOTED MAIL BALLOT TO BE  
COUNTED?**

San Bernardino County's Registrar of Voters, Kari Verjil, wants to remind voters who are casting a ballot by mail for the November 3<sup>rd</sup> Consolidated Election that the deadline for returning the ballot is 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, November 3, 2009.

- Be sure to allow enough time for delivery by mailing the ballot as soon as possible. A special ballot pickup from the main post office will be made at 8:00 p.m. on Election Night. Any ballots received after that time will not be counted.
- The ballot can be dropped off at any polling place on Election Day, or at the Registrar of Voters' office from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
- The Registrar of Voters will also be open on Saturday, October 31<sup>st</sup> from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. for early voting and mail ballot drop-off.

**REMEMBER** – you must return the ballot personally. If you are unable to return your ballot personally, you must authorize a specific family member to do so, in writing, on your mail ballot return envelope.
