

Woman airlifted after Nat'l Trails Hwy crash Tuesday morning

Another woman arrested for previous warrant, according to officials **Paola Baker, Daily Press** Posted: July 19, 2016, 12:09 PM

VICTORVILLE — Authorities rescued a woman trapped in her vehicle following a crash on National Trails Highway Tuesday morning, officials said.

Reports of a crash involving two vehicles on National Trails Highway just before Air Expressway were first received at 10:10 a.m. Tuesday. San Bernardino County Sheriff's Victorville Station spokeswoman Mara Rodriguez said a woman was briefly trapped in her vehicle and airlifted to a trauma center with injuries.

The crash occurred after a woman, identified as Crystal Fenstermaker, 37, of Apple Valley, was entering the roadway in a 1993 Izuzu Rodeo from Emma Jean's Holland Burger Cafe and pulled into the path of a 2001 Toyota Camry. The driver of the Camry swerved to miss the Rodeo and ran off the road into a drainage ditch, Rodriguez said.

The driver did not sustain any injuries, but his passenger, described by scanner traffic as a 23-year-old woman, had to be extricated from the Camry. **San Bernardino County Fire Department** Captain Mike McClintock said the extrication took 30 minutes due to heavy entrapment. The woman was airlifted to Arrowhead Regional Medical Center for treatment.

A little girl was also reported to be in the Camry at the time of the crash. Rodriguez said the child was fastened in a child car seat and did not appear to have any injuries but was taken to a local hospital, as a precaution.

A section of National Trails Highway between Air Expressway and the D Street on-ramp was briefly closed following the crash. Traffic was reported to be moving smoothly just before noon.

Fenstermaker was cited for driving with a suspended license and booked into the High Desert Detention Center on an outstanding warrant, Rodriguez said. County jail records show the warrant was for a previous assault on a person case.

Fenstermaker is being held in lieu of \$25,000 bail for the assault warrant and is scheduled to appear in court at 12:30 p.m. Wednesday.
