Glen Helen Fire Crews Help Preserve Historic Landmark.

If you have ever driven through the City of Needles chances are you have seen the Historic Route 66 signs. Sitting along that familiar landmark is another historic sight: the Needles Wayside Rest Area. Unfortunately this rest area has seen neglect throughout the years and has become dilapidated and overgrown with vegetation. The Needles Downtown Business Association chose to do something about it.
