

Aggressive Fire Attack Saves Residence

At approximately 6:35 pm dispatch received reports of a house on fire in the City of Adelanto. The first engine arrived on scene at 11229 Meredith street within nine minutes and reported a two story residence with heavy smoke showing from the garage of the home. Firefighters on scene initiated an aggressive coordinated attack that proved successful, having the fire under control within 14 minutes.

An early search of the residence revealed all occupants exited the structure prior to arrival. The fire was contained to the garage with minimal damage to the rest of the home. Damages are estimated to be \$30,000 with approximately \$175,000 saved.

A total of 18 personnel responded to the incident including one battalion chief, four engines, one truck, a brush patrol and an investigator. No injuries were reported to civilians or firefighter. The cause of the fire is still under investigation.
