County Fire Battles Structure Fire in Lucerne Valley

On Tuesday March 1st just before 9:30 p.m. #SBCoFD received reports of a structure fire at the 6900 block of Camp Rock Rd. in Lucerne Valley. Initial reports stated their living room was on fire and residents advised all occupants were out of the house.

County Fire Medic Engine 8 arrived on scene in 15 minutes to find a doublewide mobile home well involved with fire. Crews went into the attack mode and performed a primary search for any potential victims, which checked clear after a thorough search.

County Fire responded with two paramedic engine companies, 1 paramedic brush patrol, one water tender and one battalion chief for a total of 11 personnel. Cal Fire assisted with one engine and one battalion chief and Big Bear City Fire responded with one paramedic engine as well. The fire was knocked down in approximately 30 minutes and there were no injuries to civilians or firefighters. There were 4 occupants of the home that have been displaced and were relocated with family.
