

The San Bernardino County Fire Department is conducting Home Assessments throughout our Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) areas to create Fire Safe and Defensible Homes.

An assessment, by your local SBCoFD engine company, is the first step in this process. The details of that assessment are found on the Fire Safe Home Checklist. We encourage every resident in our Wildland Urban Interface areas to complete the checklist. Having a Fire Safe and Defensible Home will significantly reduce the devastating impacts of wildfire on you, your family, and your neighbors.
