Raymond Brown reported on the various programs that are beginning at the state and national levels. The NGPO (National Geospatial Programs Office) is being started under the guidance of the USGS. This brings the “National Map”, the Federal Geographic Data Committee, and the Geospatial One-Stop all under the same office.

6.0 SCAG Subcommittee Reports

Discussion:

Cameron Brown demoed the use of the SANBAG Metadata Explorer. The user interface for the web site is ready and users can start to upload their own metadata. Users can access the metadata service through ArcCatalog and using the web address of <http://maps.sanbag.ca.gov>, and users can acquire a user name and password by email Cameron at cbrown@sanbag.ca.gov. SANBAG also hosts a IMS site with various county-wide datasets including land use, general plan, and aerial photos.

Lisa Pierce spoke on CAP Grants and that many will be readily available in the coming year and to contact her for any new information regarding the CAP grants.

New terrain data at 1-foot resolution is being produced by Intermap.

AirPhotoUSA is offering their new 2005 aerials for the same prices as last year. The resolution is 1-foot standard for all of San Bernardino County (excluding remote desert areas).
