Public invited to September 11 Remembrance Ceremony

The public is invited to attend a County of San Bernardino September 11 Remembrance Ceremony in observance of the fifth anniversary of the 2001 terrorist attacks at 7 a.m. on Monday, September 11, 2006, at the west entrance to the County Government Center, 385 N. Arrowhead Ave. in San Bernardino.

The ceremony will feature the tolling of the County Fire Bell at the exact moments the World Trade Center towers were struck by hijacked airliners. The ceremony will also feature a salute to the U.S. Flag, the release of birds, and comments by County Fire Chief Pat Dennen and Board of Supervisors Chairman Bill Postmus.

A plaque in honor of the victims will also be unveiled, and will be later installed as a permanent fixture near the County Government Center fountain.

Free public parking is available directly north and east of the County Government Center.
