Department gives parents chance to re-instate licenses

August is Child Support Awareness Month and the San Bernardino County Department of Child Support Services is sponsoring events that highlight the department's services to families.

The department will participate in the state-sponsored "Get Back on the Road" Driver License Release Program. Individuals who have had their driver's license or any state-issued license suspended for nonpayment of child support will have the opportunity to have their licenses re-instated by making payments toward their child support.

"Child Support Awareness Month is a time for the department to educate the public about the services our department offers to families," said Director Connie Brunn.
